



On the way to the Park you go through Olmué, a picturesque town known by its microclimate during the whole year. Trekking over part of the route that the English naturalist, Charles Darwin did in 1834 in La Campana Mountain, declared by UNESCO, a World Biosphere Reserve. Amazing landscapes and vegetation, including the Chilean Palm Tree, *Jubaea Chilensis*, one of the two southernmost palms in the World, describe this unbelievable experience together with the reading of some of Darwin's manuscripts.

Difficulty degree Not big difficulties, good level of fitness and previous trekking experience is advisable.

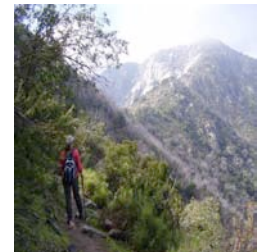
Restrictions Heart problems, asma. age limit: 14 years old.
